






RADICAL FAMILY ENGAGEMENT


Who is a Parent Leader?

is celebrated every year in February!





Key Concepts to Know

- ▶ Content always mirrors outline from CB
 - ▶ System is open now for reports
- ▶ Log in information you have previously received is still valid
 - ▶ Each state was sent information on log in to Primary Lead
 - ▶ Other users can be added and would have their own user account and password
 - ▶ Contact Edi Winkle to add at ewinkle@friendsnrc.org
- ▶ New features introduced this winter include:
 - ▶ Ability to email content of report/application directly from system – eliminating the need for downloads.
 - ▶ Enhanced editing options including font features, tables, images and more.
 - ▶ Narratives are now shared in word that allow easier editing/sharing for feedback on your teams.
