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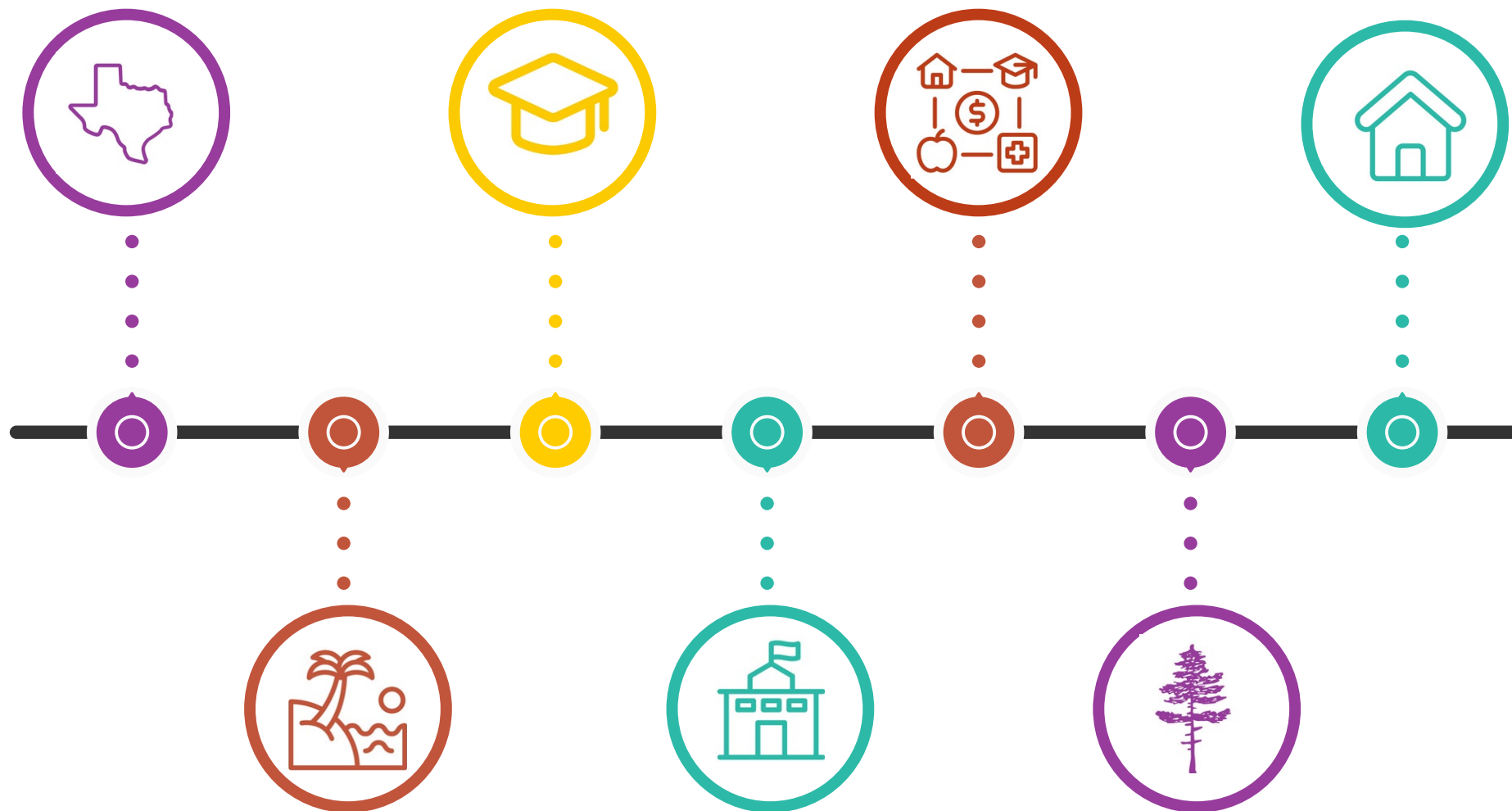

Looking Forward | Priority Considerations

- ★ Advanced Prevention Network
- ★ Assist states in building capacity of new and existing CBCAP-funded organizations
- ★ Public Awareness Materials
 - Beyond preventing something bad (child abuse) to promoting something good (family Well-being)
- ★ Map of state-specific CBCAP initiatives/work
 - Real time data on areas of focus per state (e.g. HOPE Initiative, Mandatory Supporting)
- ★ Increased support around leveraging additional funding sources
- ★ Customizable toolkit to use for leveraging funds
