Dear Grantee,

Please find guidance on the period of availability for the Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention Grants (CBCAP) authorized through the CAPTA Reauthorization Act of 2010, Public Law 111-320 and 42 U.S.C.5116 et.seq.

These grants have a 3 year project period per the statute. The period begins on the first day of the fiscal year (October 1) and continues up to the last day of the 3rd fiscal year (September 30). Regardless of the grant award issue date in the fiscal year the 3 year project period applies.
