## 1-60

Goal > Participants will work in small groups of 4-6 people (5 is ideal) and have one minute to take turns counting from 1-60 on a provided sheet of paper

| Equipment Needed | One sheet of paper printed with the numbers one through 60, broken into 5 random <br> groups on the paper (see example) |
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| Time Needed | 5 minutes so that you can explain (but not too much!), do the activity, and discuss |
| Logistics | This is dependent on the size of your group. Ideally a table will have 5-6 participants for <br> each sheet of paper. |
| Rules/Instructions | The participants will decide which section they will be assigned to. Participants can only <br> touch the numbers in their assigned section. When the timer starts, the participant whose <br> section has 1 will point to the 1, then the participant whose section has the 2 will point to <br> the 2, etc. |
| CPPR <br> Goals/Message | This activity is designed to illustrate that partnership takes effort. Each group will have a <br> different strategy for completing the task. We often repeat the activity and invariably <br> groups improve the second time - this is a great analogy for the way collaboration works. |
