It has Been a Year by the numbers: ~22 new state leads during last calendar year

~72% of Needs Assess. respondents report some or substantial systems change in their state and a shift to a prevention mindset

~From 2021 Needs Assessment re: ARPA Funding-states plans:

- 77% strengthen prevention infrastructure
- 73% provide concrete supports
- 67% strengthen parent leadership and engagement
